**1950-1955** Lord's Indexed Street Atlas of Eastern Middlesex County

**1950's** Map with street guide and fire alarms in designated folder

Reading—medium sized double map with recreation areas on one side and elementary school sites on the other side. Three copies of topo maps along with Reading Chronicle inventory of local recreation areas

**1951** Reading Quadrangle-1 torn copy with 2 smaller copies (1 of those torn) in designated folder

**1957** Reading street map—large with ads and street index

**1959** Small 8 1/2 X 11 copy of Col. Nichols Plan of the First Parish of Reading-designated folder
